



Barclays Sustainable Finance Conference

Yosemite Clean Energy's CEO Tom Hobby attended the Barclays Sustainable Finance Conference in New York, a meeting of world-leading financial experts who gave attendees a vision of the future clean energy transition. Tom had the opportunity to meet with C.S. Venkatakrisnan, CEO of Barclays Group, multiple times throughout the conference. Barclays is leading the world in H2 investment, and the conference brought a more clear focus to the energy transition as an economic driver that will disrupt traditional energy companies and create investment alternatives, provide new jobs, reduce carbon emissions, and create new asset classes that investors will be able to build into renewable portfolios.

Tom also had the opportunity to meet with Wyoming Governor Mark Gordon, who delivered a presentation on his state's carbon negative mandate. The Governor specifically mentioned the need to convert biomass from dead and rotting trees into renewable fuels to reduce the threat of catastrophic wildfires. After the session, Hobby was able to discuss with the Governor the potential for Yosemite Clean Energy to aid Wyoming in meeting their biomass utilization and negative carbon goals. The Governor was very familiar with bioenergy, and welcomed Yosemite to meet with his State forestry leaders to discuss the commercial opportunities to bring renewable energy jobs and help the State restore healthy forests that have been negatively impacted by pine beetles.
